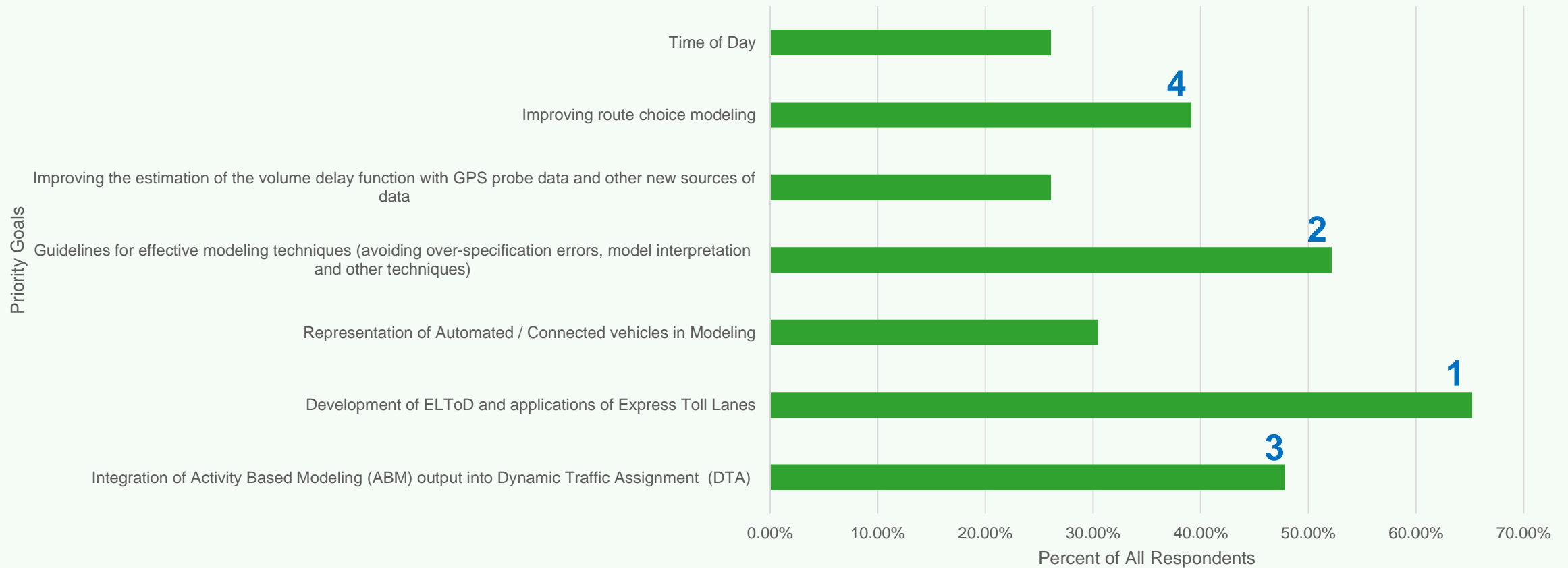

Background

- The objective of the July 2015 survey was to gain responses from the MAC members and friends about their opinions and suggestions for the goals of this committee.
- The survey link was open from July 17 to July 31, 2015.
- 23 responses that included consultants, FDOT employees, MPO employees and University Staff / Professors.

Conclusions

- Priority Goal 1. Three ELToD Workshops were given between March and April 2016. Turnpike is working in adding dynamic assignment to ELToD process.
- Priority Goal 2. MAC team was tasked to conduct a survey to understand how the FSUTMS models are being applied, their effectiveness and what areas need improvement. The survey identified concerns, potential improvements of models and usage of models for different purposes. Results were thoroughly discussed on the May 26, 2016 MAC meeting.
- Priority Goal 3. No work has been done so far.
- Priority Goal 4. No work has been done so far. Central Office is evaluating developing a proposal to improve route choice in FSUTMS models.
